

Joseph Proud

1745-1826




Born: March 22, 1745, Beaconsfield, Buckinghamshire, England.
Died: August 3, 1826, Handsworth, Warwickshire, England.

Son of a Baptist minister, Proud served Baptist churches at Knipton, Fleet, and Norwich, England, before joining the Swedenborgian denomination in 1788. He went on to pastor in Birmingham, Manchester, and London. He published a volume of 300 hymns in 1790, and a small book of hymns for children in 1810. Many of his compositions continue to be used in Swedenborgian services. His obituary:


